



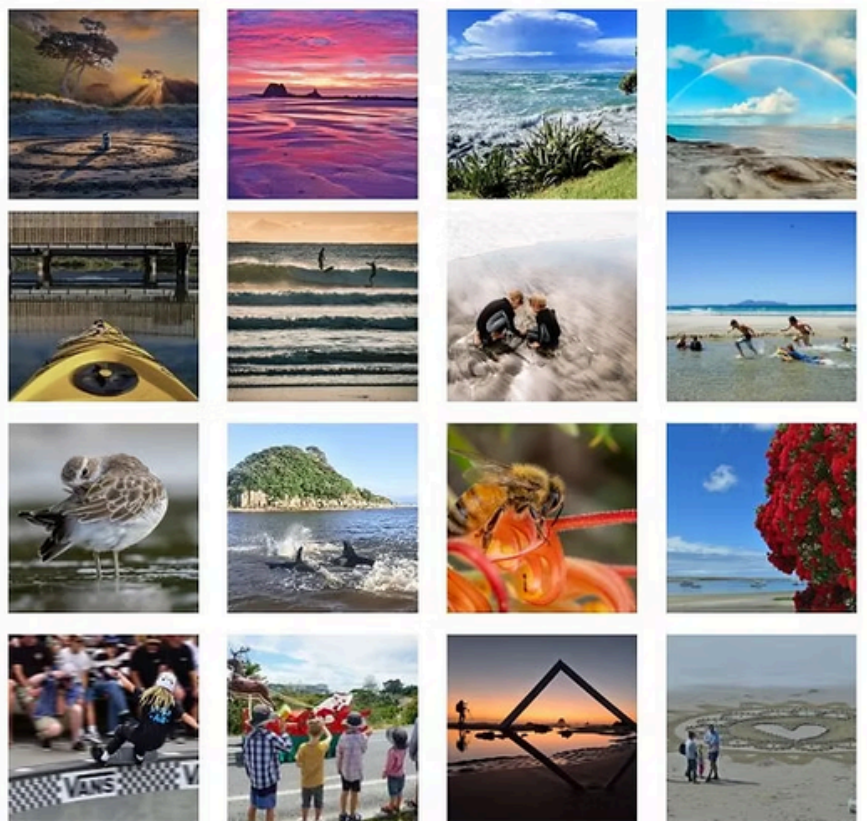
We have had a busy start to our Lions year starting with Chartering the Mangawhai Lions Club. A very special time for our Club and a honour to be founding members.

We are looking forward to working within Mangawhai and continuing to forge relationships with other community groups to make this the best little town ever!



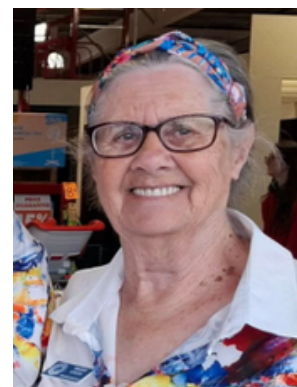

Each year Te Whai distributes over 400 food parcels to people in the Mangawhai community in need of food. Aroha Baskets consist of food and basic hygiene products depending on the needs of the individual or whānau the parcel is for.

Funding for this service has been dramatically reduced and the proceeds of this Housie fundraiser will directly support the provision of Aroha Baskets for those in need within our local community.

\$25+ a non-perishable food item gets you 30 games and a light afternoon tea, games 15 and 30 will be SUPER Houses and pay out double. There will also be some great raffles available at \$2 per ticket.

\$1,500 has been pledged to the North Haven Hospice towards the purchase for new ceiling hoists in their in patient units. This is a joint project with other Lions Clubs in our Zone that include : Waipu, Marsden, Paparoa, Ruawai , Whangarei Mid Western and Dargaville

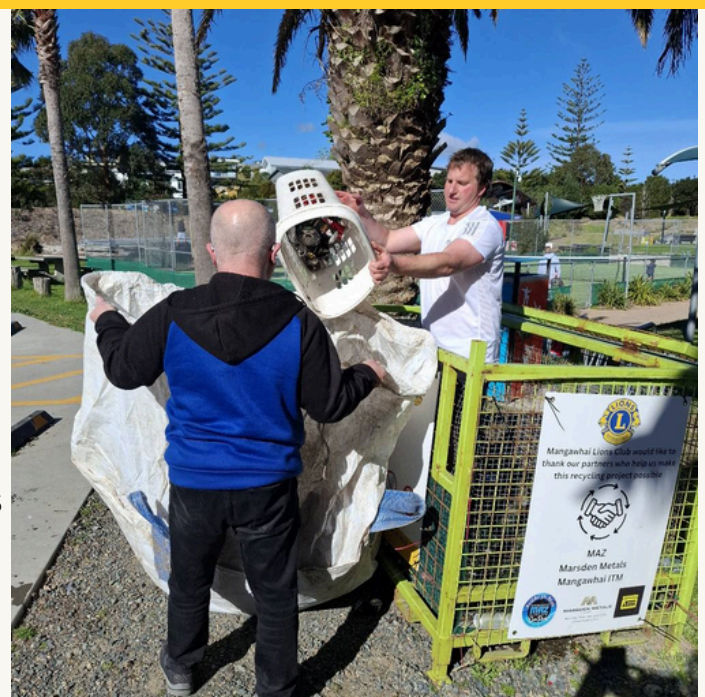


Can Cage
