 - c. Reproduction of winning images for publicity purposes.

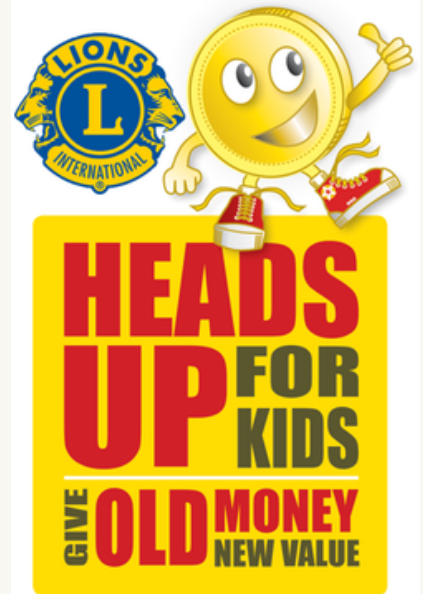
